BAR/BRI Patent Bar Review Policies and Procedures

COURSE TUITION, RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. I understand that my initial enrollment payment of \$100 is **NON-REFUNDABLE** and will be applied toward my outstanding balance (tuition, plus refundable DVD/CD deposit, plus any applicable taxes). I understand that I shall be responsible for the amount of any local, state or federal tax levied on the course, including sales tax (as determined by course location), and what the advertised tuition price does not include sales tax. Once the initial \$100 payment has been paid, I will receive the most recent edition of the Manual of Patent Examining Procedure and my tuition is guaranteed for **up to two years** from the date of initial enrollment. No other materials shall be released or mailed to me until the entire course tuition has been paid in full.
2. Upon my request, BAR/BRI will bill a law firm or a company that I direct it to bill for my course tuition. However, I understand that I must pay the refundable DVD/CD deposit payment, and that I am still solely BAR/BRI for the timely payment of the full course price, refundable deposit, and any applicable taxes even though BAR/BRI sends a bill to a law firm or company. I **FURTHER UNDERSTAND THAT ALL MONEY OWED MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE I AM ELIGIBLE TO ATTEND CLASS LECTURES AND/OR RECEIVE ANY COURSE BOOKS AND/OR MATERIALS** and that the books and/or materials will be shipped to me via United Parcel Service ground delivery to my mailing address. I acknowledge that I am responsible for informing BAR/BRI of any change of address. Course materials will not be shipped to post office boxes.
3. I agree to comply promptly and fully with all rules, regulations, and policies regarding the BAR/BRI Patent Bar Review course as from time to time announced or published by BAR/BRI. Failure to comply with these rules, regulations, and policies or with any term or condition of this Agreement shall automatically terminate my right to attend class lectures or to receive any further training from BAR/BRI. BAR/BRI reserves the right to cancel a course location if there is insufficient student interest.
4. I acknowledge that I will be charged \$250 per book for any replacement books that I request from BAR/BRI to replace any lost or stolen books.

DVD/CD DEPOSIT

1. I understand that the BAR/BRI Patent Bar Review Homestudy Program is a lease program and is not a purchase. The program is only valid for one administration of the Patent Bar Exam. All DVDs and CDs must be returned to the BAR/BRI office within 25 days of receipt. **FAILURE TO RETURN ANY AND ALL DVDS/CDS SHALL CONSTITUTE THEFT OF PROPERTY, AND MAY CRIMINAL LIABILITY. I UNDERSTAND THAT ANY BREACH OF THIS AGREEMENT MAY RESULT IN DISCLOSURE TO THE CHARACTER AND FITNESS COMMITTEE OF THE UNITED STATES PATENT AND TRADE-MARK OFFICE.**
2. I agree that I must pay a refundable DVDs/CDs deposit for the lease. This deposit will be refunded to me if I return all of the DVDs/CDs to the BAR/BRI office within 25 business days of receipt. I must return all of the DVDs CDs in person or by prepaid United Parcel Service mail to BAR/BRI within 25 days in order to receive my DVDs/CDs deposit. BAR/BRI will refund my DVDs/CDs deposit within 75 days of receipt.
3. I acknowledge that I will be charged and additional \$200 if I do not return the DVDs/CDs within 25 business days.
